Instructions

1. Use a separate form for each nomination. Projects may be nominated for more than one category.
2. **Nominees must either reside or practice in Hawai'i** (projects or primary contributor(s) must be located in Hawai'i). Both Hawai'i Chapter members and the public are invited to submit nominations (nominator must also be identified).
3. Each nomination shall include the following:
 - One copy of the completed nomination form, including a one-page summary explaining why the nominee is worthy of an award and how the nominee fulfills the evaluation criteria noted below in pdf format.
 - A \$75 nomination fee for each nomination and category entered (check made payable to "APA Hawai'i Chapter"). All fees are due with the submittal **by 4 PM on June 9, 2017**. No exceptions.
 - One item of supporting material (e.g., plan documents or graphics. Videos, presentations, letters of recommendations are not accepted.) in pdf format to be considered by the judges on compact disc (CD). **DO NOT E-MAIL FILES**. Materials will not be returned.
5. APA Hawai'i will coordinate with Award Recipients to prepare an exhibit board illustrating award winning projects for display at the awards program. Award winners will also receive framed award certificates and be publicly recognized at the HCPO Conference on September 20, 2017.
