### *Exam Review Sessions for Autumn 2012*

The American Institute of Certified Planners is the professional arm of the American Planning Association. AICP certifies practicing city, regional, and rural planners and promotes continuing education, ethics, and professional development. To join AICP, members must submit an application to APA and take a three-hour written examination. The computer-based exam is offered during a two-week period in May and November of each year.

The fall exam is scheduled for November 5-19, 2012.
